Dear Senator Hatch:

Thank you for your letter regarding the antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) orders on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (China). I appreciate the importance of these issues to you and your constituents, and am pleased to address your concerns.

The Department of Commerce (the Department) is currently conducting two scope inquiries to determine whether specific 5000 series products fall within the scope of the AD and CVD orders on imports of aluminum extrusions from China. In both of these scope inquiries, the Department is considering the comments submitted by interested parties, and is currently scheduled to issue its final scope rulings for the scope inquiry requests submitted by Kota International and Trending Imports on October 8, 2014. In accordance with our regulations, the Department will fully consider all information submitted on the record in its final determinations in these inquiries.

The Department is committed to the robust enforcement of the trade remedy laws, in order to help provide U.S. firms and workers the opportunity to compete on a level playing field. Please be assured that these proceedings will be conducted in an open and transparent manner in full compliance with U.S. law, regulations and obligations.
